DIRECTIONS

Use address on front of brochure for GPS directions.

I-16 From Macon

- Travel east on I-16. Take the Statesboro/Claxton exit (Exit 116).
- Turn left onto Hwy 301 N. towards Statesboro.
- Travel through 3 traffic lights until the 4th traffic light at the Highway 301 Bypass/ Veterans Memorial Pkwy.
- Turn right onto the bypass (Hwy 301 N.)
- Go through 6 traffic lights and take a right at the 7th light onto Hwy 24 towards Oliver/Newington.
- Mill Creek Park is approximately 1 mile on the right (through 1 traffic light). Enter through the main (second) entrance.

I-16 From Savannah

- Travel west on I-16. Take the Statesboro exit (Exit 127).
- Turn right onto Hwy 67 N. towards Statesboro.
- After 10 miles, turn right at the traffic light at the Hwy 301 Bypass/ Veterans Memorial Pkwy.
- At the third traffic light, turn right onto Hwy 24 (Oliver/Newington).
- Mill Creek Park is approximately 1 mile on the right (through 1 traffic light). Enter through the main (second) entrance.

Hwy 25/80 From Augusta/Swainsboro

- Travel east on Hwy 8o.
- Upon entering Statesboro, travel to Hwy 80/301 North intersection (Enmark gas station will be on the left). Continue through Hwy 80/301 N. intersection on Hwy 80. Go through 1 traffic light (Advanced Auto Parts will be on the left).
- At the next traffic light (Bright Ideas on left), turn left onto East Main Street (Hwy 24 to Oliver/Newington).
- Travel approximately 3 miles (through 2 traffic lights).
- Mill Creek Park is approximately 1 mile on the right (through 1 traffic light). Enter through the main park (second) entrance.

ABOUT THE RIDE

Quiet back roads, beautiful rural scenery, and little elevation change make the Jim Kruse Century a fun and family friendly ride.

Saturday's ride offers a 25, 50, 65, and continuous 100 mile option. All routes are mapped, marked, and well-sagged. Coffee and breakfast snacks will be available at the ride start. Saturday's pre-registered riders receive a T-shirt, ride packet, map, emergency vehicle support and post-ride lunch. Sunday's free ride is an informal 45 mile group ride that will have no rest stops.

Ride Cost: \$35 each rider

NOTE: There is a \$5 late fee for walk-ups
